

Identification Evidence

On the 29 April 2016, a new Garda Vetting process was introduced and as part of this, all individuals must provide identification evidence to allow the Gardaí to process the vetting.

Evidence is required by the following individuals:

- Persons, who are over 16 years old but under 18 years old and who shall be working in an Irish College.
- Persons, who are over 18 years old and are consenting as Parents/Guardians for their minor children to be vetted.
- Person over 18 years old who shall be working in the Irish College.

Each individual needs to obtain a score of 100 marks each.

Under 18 years old:

One document of evidence is required to obtain the 100 marks.

- Birth Certificate
- Passport
- Letter from Principal confirming name, address of student and their attendance at school.

Over 18 years old

Each identification document has a mark scoring but no one document has a score of 100 marks on its own. Therefore, two types of evidence are needed to obtain a score of 100 marks.
